Entrance Examination for Admission to Post Graduate Medical [Degree/Diploma] Courses, Kerala –2004

NOTIFICATION

1. Applications are invited for the Entrance Examination for admission to P G Medical [Degree/Diploma] Courses for the year 2004 in the Government Medical Colleges in Kerala.

2. Eligibility for Admission

- i) Nativity. Applicant should be an Indian citizen of Kerala origin.
- ii) Academic qualifications: M.B.B.S Degree from any of the Universities in Kerala or of any other University, recognized by the Universities in Kerala as equivalent thereto with eligibility for full registration in respect of all courses. <u>Applicants who have completed *Compulsory Rotating Resident Internship* (CRRI) on or before **31-12-2003** are also eligible for writing the Entrance Examination.</u>
- iii) Age: Maximum age as on **31-12-2003** for different categories will be as follows:

General candidates: For Degree/Diploma Courses : 45 Years
Service candidates: For Degree Courses : 47 Years
Service candidates: For Diploma Courses : 48 years

3. Selection and Entrance Examination:

Selection of <u>General and Service</u> Candidates to State Quota seats will be made on the basis of an Entrance Examination to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) at **Thiruvananthapuram**, **Emakulam and Kozhikode** on **27-03-2004 (Saturday)**. It will consist of **two** papers, each of **two** hours duration and having **150** objective type (*Multiple Choices*) questions each.

- 4. **Application forms:** Prospectus and application form will be available from **04-02-2004** in the official Website of the CEE at **'cee-kerala.org"**. Different application forms have been prescribed for General and Service candidates. Candidates seeking admission to this course can apply in the prescribed format (General or Service, as applicable), after downloading it, along with necessary documents and a Demand Draft for **Rs. 800**/- (Rupees Eight Hundred Only), drawn on **SBT/SBI**, in favor of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, payable at Thiruvananthapuram. Application forms will not be sold from this Office or from the office of the DME Application fees once remitted will not be refunded on any account.
- 5. Last date and time for receipt of filled-in application forms: Candidates including Service candidates seeking admission should forward their completed application with all the required documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Housing Board Buildings, Santhinagar, Thiruvananthapuram 695 001, either by Registered post or hand delivery so as to reach him before 5 pm on

Wednesday, 3^a March, 2004 However, Service candidates should send a copy of their Application Form, along with copies of all required documents to their Controlling Officer also.

Late applications including those brought after 5 PM on 03-03-2004 will not be accepted. Candidates are advised to apply for the examination well in advance. The CEE will not be responsible for any postal delay.

Belated, incomplete, defective and wrongly addressed applications will be summarily rejected and no correspondence will be undertaken in this regard.

Candidates will neither be allowed to include any information in the application form nor to submit any certificates / documents claiming reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the application, under any circumstances.

Candidates must note that they have to obtain the required certificates in the body of the Application form itself, wherever specified. The certificates that are attached separately along with the application form will not be considered under any circumstances.

The CEE will conduct the Entrance Examination, publish a Rank list of General candidates based on merit as assessed at the Entrance Examination and forward the same to the Director of Medical Education. <u>A list of Service candidates</u>, who qualify, in the entrance examination will also be prepared and forwarded to the DME.

The selection, admission and allotment of seats including those under Service Quota will be made by the Director of Medical Education, based on various provisions laid down in the Prospectus, approved by the Government.

6. Candidates may go through the Prospectus for admission to the Post Graduate Medical [Degree/Diploma] Courses 2004, approved by the Govt. of Kerala and published by the Director of Medical Education and available at the web-site 'cee-kerala.org' for the details regarding the entrance examination and the course, including the seat distribution, reservation etc., under various categories, before filling the application form.
